These six brothers also accompanied me, & we entered the man's house. ¹³He told us how he had seen the angel standing in his house & saying, 'Send to Joppa & bring Simon [Peter]... ¹⁴he will give you a message by which you & your entire household will be saved.' ¹⁵And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as it had upon us at the beginning. ¹⁶And I remembered the word of the Lord... 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' ¹⁷If then God gave them the same gift that he gave us when we believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could hinder God?" ¹⁸...And they praised God, saying, "Then God has given even to the Gentiles the repentance that leads to life."
