SERMON TEXT- Genesis 24:34-51

³⁴ So he said, "I am Abraham's servant. ³⁵ The LORD has greatly blessed my master, & he has become great. He has given him flocks & herds, silver & gold, male servants & female servants, camels & donkeys... ³⁷ My master made me swear, saying, 'You shall not take a wife for my son from the daughters of the Canaanites, in whose land I dwell, ³⁸ but you shall go to my father's house & to my clan & take a wife for my son.' ³⁹ I said to my master, 'Perhaps the woman will not follow me.' ⁴⁰ But he said to me, 'The LORD, before whom I have walked, will send his angel with you & prosper your way. You shall take a wife for my son from my clan & from my father's house. ⁴¹ Then you will be free from my oath, when you come to my clan. And if they will not give her to you, you will be free from my oath.' ⁴² "I came today to the spring & said, 'O LORD, the God of my master Abraham, if now you are prospering the way that I go, ⁴³ behold, I am standing by the spring of water. Let the virgin who comes out to draw water, to whom I shall say, 'Please give me a little water from your jar to drink,' ⁴⁴ & who will say to me, 'Drink, & I will draw for your camels also,' let her be the woman whom the LORD has appointed for my master's son.' ⁴⁵ "Before I had finished speaking in my heart, behold, Rebekah came out with her water jar on her shoulder... Then I asked her, 'Whose daughter are you?' She said, 'The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bore to him.' So I put the ring on her nose & the bracelets on her arms. ⁴⁸ Then I bowed my head & worshiped the LORD & blessed the LORD, the God of my master Abraham, who had led me by the right way to take the daughter of my master's kinsman for his son. ⁴⁹ Now then, if you are going to show steadfast love & faithfulness to my master, tell me; & if not, tell me, that I may turn to the right hand or to the left.' ⁵⁰ Then Laban & Bethuel answered & said, "The thing has come from the LORD; we cannot speak to you bad or good. ⁵¹ Behold, Rebekah is before you; take her & go, & let her be the wife of your master's son, as the LORD has spoken."

Let the virgin who comes out to draw water, to whom I shall say, 'Please give me a little water from your jar to drink,' ⁴⁴ & who will say to me, 'Drink, & I will draw for your camels also,' let her be the woman whom the LORD has appointed for my master's son.' ⁴⁵ "Before I had finished speaking in my heart, behold, Rebekah came out with her water jar on her shoulder... Then I asked her, 'Whose daughter are you?' She said, 'The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bore to him.' So I put the ring on her nose & the bracelets on her arms. ⁴⁸ Then I bowed my head & worshiped the LORD & blessed the LORD, the God of my master Abraham, who had led me by the right way to take the daughter of my master's kinsman for his son. ⁴⁹ Now then, if you are going to show steadfast love & faithfulness to my master, tell me; & if not, tell me, that I may turn to the right hand or to the left." ⁵⁰ Then Laban & Bethuel answered & said, "The thing has come from the LORD; we cannot speak to you bad or good. ⁵¹ Behold, Rebekah is before you; take her & go, & let her be the wife of your master's son, as the LORD has spoken."
